

## **AOA Small Breeder Definition**

### **New for 2018:**

Novice Small Breeder Shows are intended to encourage new or novice breeders to show their alpacas with other similarly sized farms. These shows are meant to foster and further the education of novice and/or small breeders through class placements and judge comments. A farm qualifies as a novice/small breeder when it has no more than 20 AOA registered females at the time of registration for that show and has owned alpacas for 10 years or less. Show Superintendents shall verify eligibility through an active AOA account and/or Owner of Record for Show Entry.
